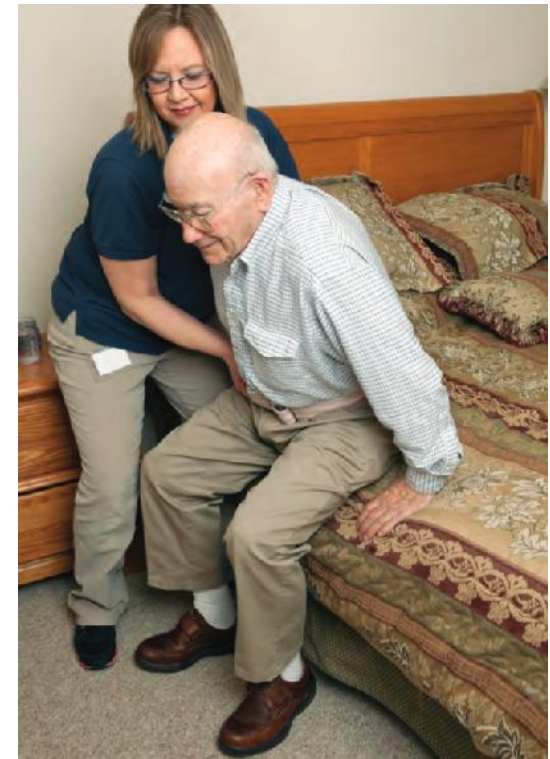
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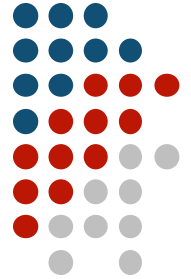
Supportive Services & Aging in Place



- Most older adults want to age in their homes
- Living in nursing homes or assisted living facilities is very expensive
- Supportive services in home and community settings can achieve better health outcomes
- States are looking to offer long-term care in home & community settings



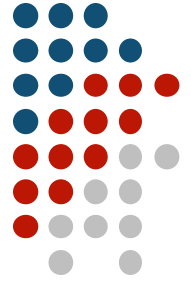
Barriers to Aging in Place



- Difficulty completing activities of daily living (ADLs) and instrumental activities of daily living (IADLs)
- Lack of access to transportation
- Managing household chores and finances if impaired physically or cognitively
- Social isolation

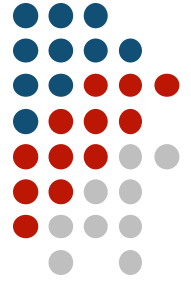


Models for Different Kinds of Communities

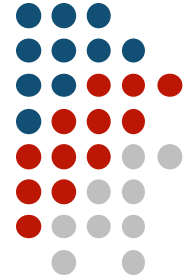


- Multifamily buildings in urban neighborhoods
- Single-family homes & small multifamily buildings in suburban neighborhoods
- Single-family homes dispersed in rural communities

- Guided by the preferences of older adults
- Evolved to serve a wide range of needs
- Built upon partnerships with service providers and community stakeholders
