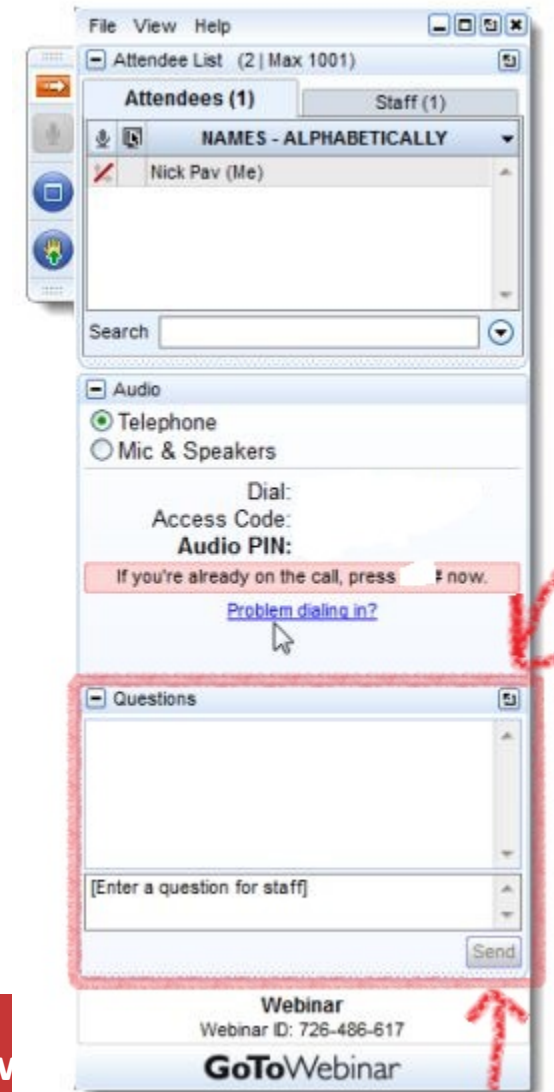
About NHC

Importance of broadband in affordable housing

- 80% of students need internet access to complete homework assignments.
- 90% of job applications are online.
- Job seekers with at-home internet find employment seven weeks faster.
- The Free Application for Financial Student Aid will soon move entirely online.
