## NeighborWorks America FY '20 & '21\* Network Health Work

#### **Social Determinants of Health Work**

- 68% of our network implement work at the intersection of health, housing, and community development
- 35% of network organizations have formalized health work into their organizational strategic plans
- Network organizations most often partner with government agencies, foundations, and health centers to implement their health work
- Network organizations partner most with the health sector around programs, grants, and capital investment

#### **COVID-19 Health Response**

- Network organizations provided 737,000+ services to renters
- Network organizations provided 282,000+ renters provided with food or basic needs
- 350+ vaccination clinics were held with over
   10,000+ vaccinations provided by health partners
- Network organizations also provided mental health, social isolation, small business, and telehealth supports

# NeighborWorks America Health in Comprehensive Community Development


- Comprehensive Community
