Louisville's Housing Crisis

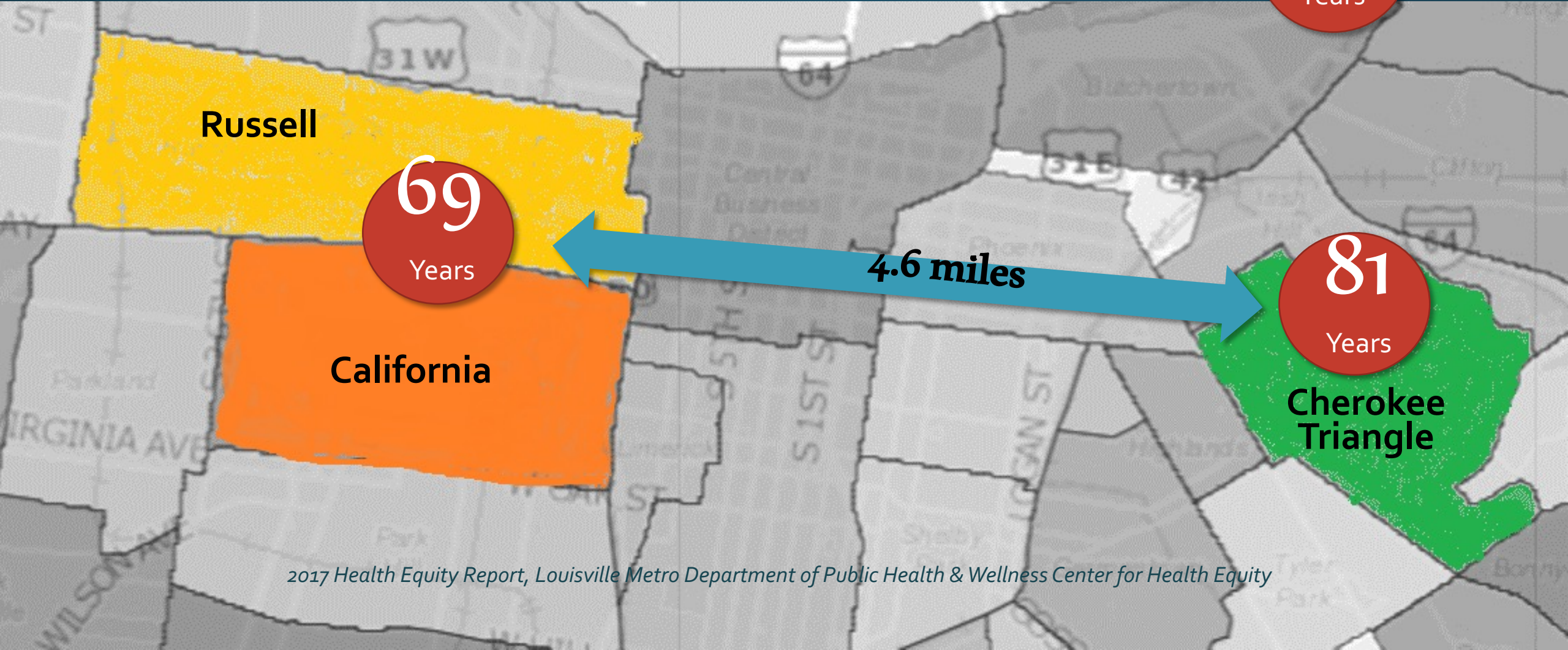
31,412 units short of affordable housing needed for those making 30% or less of Area Median Income
